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## **\*\*CONSTRUCTION ALERT\*\***

### **CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON BALDWIN AVENUE UNDERPASS AT RAILROAD CROSSING; STREET TO CLOSE FOR 24 MONTHS**

#### **WHAT**

The Alameda Corridor-East Construction Authority (ACE) has begun construction on the Baldwin Avenue Grade Separation Project at the railroad crossing on Baldwin Avenue in the City of El Monte. The project will consist of a bridge to carry trains over Baldwin Avenue and an underpass for vehicular traffic. A pedestrian bridge will span Baldwin Avenue, connecting the Bessie Avenue cul-de-sacs. Upon completion, traffic congestion, potential collisions with trains and noise from train horns from the mainline track will be eliminated.

#### **WHEN**

Underground utility relocations and preliminary work along Baldwin Avenue just north of the railroad tracks will start in March for two months. Main construction will start in May, when Baldwin Avenue is expected to be closed for construction for 24 months. Most work will take place on weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Completion of construction is anticipated in Spring 2015.

#### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

The closure of Baldwin Avenue will occur between Gidley Avenue and Rose Avenue. Local access to businesses and residences will be maintained. All vehicle and pedestrian traffic are encouraged to use detours (see map on reverse). Temple City Boulevard and Arden Drive will serve as detours for north-south traffic. To minimize impacts to local school, trucks are being encouraged to use Temple City Boulevard. Noise, dust and vibration will be monitored for compliance within applicable limits.



## AREA DETOUR MAP (SPRING 2013 - SPRING 2015)

Baldwin Ave. will be closed starting Spring 2013 and re-open approximately 24 months later. Arden Dr. and Temple City Blvd. are recommended detours for north-south traffic. Santa Anita Ave. is a detour route to Interstate 10 and 210 freeways. Access to businesses and residences on Baldwin Ave. and Gidley St. will be maintained. Valley Blvd. and Lower Azusa Rd. will remain open during construction.



## LOCAL ACCESS DETOUR MAP (SPRING 2013 - SPRING 2015)

Baldwin Avenue will be closed for approximately 24 months. Arden Dr. and Temple City Blvd. are recommended detours for local access. Access to businesses and residences on Baldwin Ave. and Gidley St. will be maintained. Valley Blvd. will remain open during construction.
