### PARADE FACTS

**Time: Parade 10:15 AM, Harvest Festival 10:30 AM - 1:30 PM**

The parade begins at Valley Mall & Tyler Avenue. Parade travels south on Tyler Avenue and concludes at Arceo Park.

There will be a Harvest Festival which will include free bikes, helmets, GameStop gift certificate giveaways, performances by parade participants, rides, bouncers, 2 cash awards for the "Most Spirited Award" and more!

### ENTRY RULES

1. All parade participants must be 18 years and under.
2. All parade participants (Adult/ Child) must have a permissionslip on file.
3. Participants must be uniformed, costumed or appropriately attired.
4. Entries may not express POLITICAL, SOCIAL, ETC. view points.
5. All entries in the parade must be approved by the Parade Committee.
6. PARADE WILL START PROMPTLY AT 10:15 AM.
7. The Parade Committee accepts no responsibility for false statements made by applicants.
8. **Forward motion (no stopping) must be maintained throughout the entire parade route.**
9. No vehicles permitted for audio sound. Music must be on push carts.
- 10 Please carry an **IDENTIFICATION BANNER.**
11. All entries must be in by **Thursday, October 2, 2014.**
12. Check-in booth open time: 9:00 AM, closing time: 9:30 AM. All units must be checked in by this time. Check map for check-in booth. A mailer will be sent prior to the parade with your number and a map.
13. No entry is allowed to hand out or throw anything along the parade route.
